The attached form is provided in order for the Northern Brazoria County Education Alliance (NBCEA) to recognize and appropriately target students that best fit your directive. These scholarships will be awarded for the Fall Semester for students enrolled in Career and Technical classes at Pearland High School and Dawson High School. Dual credit classes allow students to earn college credit hours at the local community colleges while in high school. The community colleges offers these programs at a reduced fee for high school students.

The purpose of the scholarships is to help worthy high school students follow their dreams through financial support for enrollment in dual credit technical classes. The primary consideration will be the applicant's financial need as well as their desire to take technical classes to be prepared to enter the workforce. ALL applicant's must take a **MANDATORY DRUG TEST** to qualify for a scholarship.

Dual Credit Technical Scholarships are based on:

- Being Drug Free
- Interest in furthering one's education in a technical field
- Demonstration of good character, integrity and maturity

You, as donor, may offer your scholarship(s) to a young person chosen by directing your scholarship(s) for a specific dual credit technical class.

The scholarship funds will be released directly to San Jacinto College or Alvin Community College **after the student has passed a drug test and enrolled in the class.**

The Northern Brazoria County Education Alliance is a 501(c) 3 organization. The NBCEA will distribute all money through an individual Scholarship Fund account. If a scholarship recipient chooses not to utilize the award money for the Fall semester, that scholarship will be directed to another recipient in the Spring semester.
